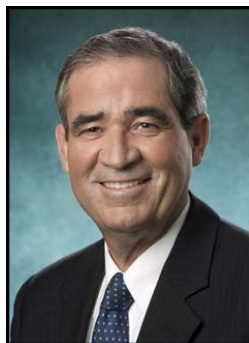

Kings County Supervisor, CalPERS Board of Administration



Tony Oliveira, Kings County Supervisor, District 3, was reappointed as the Local Government Representative to the CalPERS Board of Administration in February of 2007 by Governor Schwarzenegger. He represents more than 1,000 local government agencies since he joined the Board in September 2005.

Mr. Oliveira was elected President of the California State Association of Counties (CSAC) in November 2009 after serving in a number of CSAC leadership roles including Executive Vice President and Treasurer. He is also on the Kings County Board of Supervisors and was appointed in 2003 to the California State Appeals Board of Hazardous Waste.

He is the Chair of the CalPERS Board of Administration Ad Hoc Risk Management Committee and Vice Chair of the Investment and Health Benefits Committee. He also serves on the Benefits and Program Administration, Performance and Compensation, Finance and Ad Hoc Board Governance Committees.

Mr. Oliveira received a Masters of Business Administration degree from Pepperdine University and attended Harvard Business School's Executive Management program. He is a resident of Lemoore, is married, and has four daughters and one son.
